Associate Pastor Job Summary

The Associate Pastor will serve a key role in spiritual growth of the congregation by working alongside our Senior Pastor to help shape and tactically execute the ministry of the church consistent with the vision and values set by the church. He will also be responsible for maintaining community groups/Sunday School, building a young adult/college ministry, direct line staff management responsibilities, and other administrative duties.

Job Responsibilities

- Shepherding. The Associate Pastor will partner with the Senior Pastor and regularly meet with congregants and shepherd them through pastoral visitations, counseling, and ministry meetings. He will also be a faithful steward of his time and church resources in providing leadership for fellowship retreat and social gatherings of the church aligned with the vision and values.
- Preaching & Teaching. Under the direction of the Senior Pastor and the session, the Associate Pastor will have preaching and teaching opportunities. In addition to consistently leading Sunday worship, he will ensure Biblical and theological adherence through alignment of Sunday School and community group curriculum with the vision and values of Greenville ARP church. Additionally, he will serve as a partner to identify the spiritual needs of the congregation and implement Wednesday night teaching initiatives from the youngest members to the most senior.
- Leadership. The Associate Pastor will have direct line management responsibilities for Director of Children's Ministries, Director of Youth Ministries, and Director of the Greenville ARP Day School. The position will also require a focus on the cultivation of young adults (college, young singles, young married) ministry. There will be other leadership opportunities as well with oversight for our committee work pertinent to ministerial areas of focus, and service as an active member of the church session and denomination levels of presbytery and synod of the Associate Reformed Church.
- · Communication. With the use of multiple communication platforms including e-mail, website, and effective use of social media the Associate Pastor will serve as an active conduit between the prayer needs and special announcements of individual members and the body of the church on a consistent basis.

Qualifications & Desired Characteristics

- 2-4 years of pastoral experience preferred (visitation, preaching, and teaching).
- A strong call to serve alongside of a multi-generational congregation.
- A history of or aptitude to connect to covenant children away at college.
- Ability to lead, communicate, and build fellowship that is glorifying to God and edifying to the members of the church.
